### 3 Golden Opportunities for 4-H'ers

- 1. Southern Area Field Day, Saturday, May 4 at Mt. San Antonio College in Walnut. Compete in the Southern Area Presentation Day and Fashion Revue so you can move on to the state level competition at State Field Day on June 1. Register by April 19. No online registration is required to participate in the Consumer Science Contest, Entomology Contest, STEM Project, Southern Area Extemporaneous (Senior 4-H members only!), and Southern Area Impromptu! See you in Walnut on May 4!
- 2. 2019 State Field Day, Saturday, June 1st at UC Davis. Fashion Revue and Presentation Day are only open to 4-H'ers who have qualified at county and area levels, but anyone can register to compete in the Interview Contest, Photography Contest, Film Festival, Robotics Competition, and Livestock Quiz Bowl. Registration Deadline for those events is May 15, but NO registration is required to participate in the Judging Contest, Plant Science Contest, Logo Contest, Entomology Contest, Primary Acitivities or Robotics Drop-in Activities.
- 3. State Leadership Conference: "Planet 4-H: Planting the Seeds of Change", Thursday-Sunday, July 18-21 at UC Davis. \$299 for 2 nights and \$399 for 3 nights if you register by May 6. #### 3rd—5th Grade: Energy and Waves Physics Lab 101 | Disney Youth Education Series

Students in grades 3-5 discover light and sound as forms of energy and how to use them in practical application. In this 2.5-hour academic adventure, students see first-hand how these elements are a vital part of creating world-class attractions and how Disney uses these physical properties to entertain and amaze guests from all over the world. #### 6th—12th Grade: Properties of Motion Physics Lab | Disney Youth Education Series

During this 3-hour interactive learning experience, students in grades 6-12 will learn the role of mechanical physics at Disney California Adventure Park. Students will study Newton's laws of motion and use the scientific method to explore the practical uses of magnetism, friction, gravity and different forms of energy. With the park as their learning lab, students will perform hands-on experiments to see and test the relationship between physics and their favorite Disney attractions. **Cost:** Physics Lab is included with ticket purchase for 4-H Members. Family members may also purchase tickets at these prices: \$110 for 1-Day Ticket (California Adventure Park only), \$155 for 1-Day Park Hopper, \$210 for 2-Day Park Hopper, or \$270 for 3-Day Park Hopper.

**Transportation & Lodging:** You provide your own transportation to Anaheim and arrange/pay for your own accommodations. We will have a block of hotel rooms available at <a href="Desert Inn & Suites Hotel">Desert Inn & Suites Hotel</a> for families to book. If we don't have a minimum of 10 kids in each class, this event will be canceled, so you must register by April 4.
